## **STUDENT PARTICIPATION POLICY - INTERSCHOOL ACTIVITIES**

CIS Board of directors fully supports the participation of students in activities with other schools. Guidelines have been created to ensure students' positive representation of CIS and their enjoyment.

### **GUIDELINES:**

1. All students must arrive via school transportation for any activity off CIS campus.
2. Participants must wear their CIS uniform to all events.
3. The school will not be liable for any damages /charges on account of injuries fatal or otherwise, which may be sustained by the student, at any time. All expenses that may be incurred in the treatment of such injuries will be borne by the parents / guardian.
4. CIS students are ambassadors for our school. Those involved in interschool activities must be made aware that all school rules and expectations apply while on the school transportation and while participating in the event and the duration thereof.
5. Only students participating in the event are permitted to attend, unless specific permission is granted by the staff organizer.
