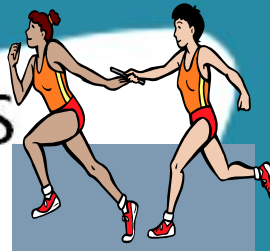

## APPEAL FOR FLOOD VICTIMS IN KARNATAKA & ANDHRA PRADESH



Dear Parents and Students of CIS,

As you are aware, there have been devastating floods in Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh in recent days. Lakhs of people are now without shelter or food.

There is already a fundraising event being organized by IB2 for Wednesday 21 October (Paid 'Dress down / Dress up'), going to the Karnataka Relief Fund.

Now, we feel as a school community we can contribute more and make a difference by helping and showing we care for the community around us. We, IB1 students have organized a donation drive of food items and clothing/blankets for the victims.

Please find below information about the collection drive.

**What items are being collected?** - Rice, Channa (chick peas), Whole wheat flour (Atta), sugar, Ragi flour, Moong Dahl, clothes. There is also a possibility to send money if you do not find the time to buy food items. All food items in one kg. bags, please.

**When will the collection take place?** - Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> October, in the morning homeroom of every class. IB1 students will keep boxes ready in all classes. Students will be reminded about the collection on Tuesday and Wednesday morning, during assembly time and homeroom.

**How will it be collected?** - Students will come to school with the items and drop them in a box in their classrooms. They must bring along the tear-off slip. Each grade level has an IB1 student representative responsible for collecting these items.

**Where will the collection go?** - The following Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> afternoon, we will have a bus arranged for transport to the Rotary club. The Rotary Club has a distribution network that will take the donated items to the victims.

**Let us give generously and show our support to the victims of the floods!!**
